What to Bring? (and what NOT to bring!)

1. Please bring your own Bible, Hymn Book, notebooks, etc.
 2. We must provide all of our own bedding (sheets, blankets, towels and pillows).
 3. Bring your own swimsuit and towels (see policies).

Available Air-Conditioned Rooms

Crowe Hall

This remodeled residence offers both private bedrooms with shared bathrooms and suites of two bedrooms with one private bathroom. Each suite has a living room. All bedrooms have two beds. The extra cost to stay here is \$8.00 per day per person for bedrooms and \$16.00 for suites. Space may be limited. Crowe Hall sits on the best location at Hanover, centrally located between all the facilities we use during the week.

Greenwood Suites

This residence offers suites of three bedrooms and two baths. Each suite has a common living room. Each bedroom has two beds, for a total of six beds in each suite. The extra cost to stay here is \$16.00 per day per person. Greenwood is often the hot spot for adults and children to socialize during the week.

Housing requests are assigned on a first-come-first-served basis.

Transportation to Hanover

For those flying in to the **Louisville** airport, we can make arrangements for the Hanover College van to transport you to the school. **The cost of the ride is \$20 for the round-trip.**

Please inform the Registrar (Bro. Mike Livermore) if you will need a ride to the airport. Please notify Mike well in advance of the Bible school. Mike will connect you with our Transportation Director (Bro. Jason Winterland) to reserve your spot on the Hanover van. Specifically, we will need to know your time of arrival, airline

being used, and your city of origination/destination. Air travelers should use the **Louisville, KY airport (SDF)** and plan to arrive Saturday the 21st before 4:00 p.m. Departures should be scheduled for after 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 29th



If you cannot make flight plans to the Louisville airport, Indianapolis and Cincinnati are just 2 hours and 1 hour, respectively, away from the Bible School. It might work to your advantage to fly to either of those two airports and rent a car for the short trip down to Hanover College.

Christadelphian Midwest Bible School Policies

WE ASK YOUR COOPERATION IN OBSERVING THESE NECESSARY POLICIES

1. Everyone using the school facilities, full or part-time, must register.
2. Please do not discuss controversial issues on the campus. No special meetings are to be held without the consent of the committee.
3. Smoking is not permitted in any Hanover Campus building. Smoking is permitted outdoors, but not encouraged. Also forbidden are drugs, alcohol, incense and ANY type of fireworks.
4. Unmarried students of the opposite sex may visit each other in the lounges and other common areas, but are not to visit in each others' rooms.
5. Please keep your room clean and neat. We are not allowed to fasten anything to the walls, move furniture from one room to another **or change rooms**. No outside sports equipment (skates, tennis rackets, balls, roller blades, etc.) may be used inside any building on the Hanover campus. We are financially responsible for any damages in the buildings.
6. We are requested to conduct ourselves in a manner reflecting our love for the Truth. Parents and/or guardians must maintain control of their children during unsupervised hours. Radios or TVs may not be played at the school. Please keep washrooms tidy. Showers may not be taken before 6:00 AM or after 11:00 PM because of the disturbance to people in nearby rooms. Please be in your room and QUIET by 11:00 PM. **Parents and guardians, before going home, PLEASE check the cleanliness of your children's and teens' rooms.**
7. If it is necessary to leave the school grounds, students participating in the teen program must obtain parent or guardian's permission, as well as the Youth Director's permission. Please observe all posted traffic regulations.
8. Students are expected to attend Devotions each morning and all class sessions during the week. The Committee reserves the right to ask students to leave the school who refuse to conduct themselves according to the rules of the school in a Christ-like spirit.
9. Parents with children 11 years old or younger will be expected to help with the appropriate children's activities.

DRESS CODE

For all ages at all times, our dress is to be modest, clean, appropriate, and non-offensive. Parents, please check the clothing that your student plans to bring to the school. Modest clothing includes dresses, skirts and blouses, dress slacks, or nice jeans. Students in grade 6 and up are not permitted to wear shorts to class. Caps are not to be worn in any building on campus.

MEMORIAL SERVICES: Sisters and young ladies are requested to wear dresses or skirts and blouses. Sisters are requested to wear head coverings. Brothers and young men are requested to wear suits, or dress slacks and collared shirts.

SPORTS: Sports attire may be worn during the recreation period. Halter tops and **low-cut pants** that expose the midriff are not appropriate clothing. Swimsuits (for males and females) are to be modest (no bikinis or abbreviated suits) and are to be worn only for swimming.
